WHAT

Licensing is a way to give your permission to others to **share** and **use** your creative work.

- It consists of different elements that can be combined,
- Each element states a **condition** that need to be followed by the **re-user**,
- Different combinations allow for **great variation** in the type of open license



Licenses cannot be revoked and only the copyright holder can apply a license.

WHY

- It **removes ambiguity** over what others can - and can't - do with your work,
- It gives a **standardized** way to grant the public permission to use your outputs,
- It is an important aspect of practising **Open Science**

CC0 allows creators to give up their copyright and imposes **no conditions**.

CC-BY lets others distribute, remix, tweak, and build upon your work, even commercially, as long as they **credit you** for the original creation.

CC-BY-SA lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work, even commercially, as long as they **credit you** and license their new creations under **identical terms**.

CC-BY-NC lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work **non-commercially**, as long as they **acknowledge you**.

CC-BY-NC-SA lets others remix, tweak, and build upon your work **non-commercially**, only if they **credit you** and license their new creations **under the identical terms**.

share

CC-BY-ND allows for commercial and non-commercial redistribution, as long as it is passed along **unchanged** and **in whole**, with **credit to you**.

CC-BY-NC-ND is the most **restrictive license**, only allowing to download your works and share them as long as they **credit you** and do not change them or share them commercially.

Copyright gives its owner the exclusive right to copy, distribute or adapt a creative work.

HOW

Choose a license and click on **Attribution 4.0 International**.

Keep the URL, paste the icon or sentence into your work, and **link** them to the URL.
