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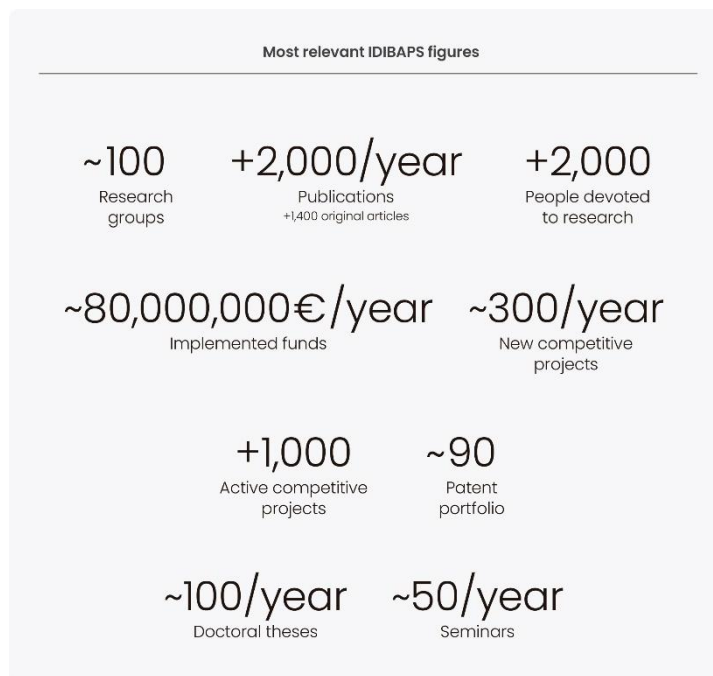
About the institution

The Barcelona Clinical Research Foundation-August Pi i Sunyer Biomedical Research Institute (IDIBAPS) is a biomedical research centre of excellence, located on the Barcelona Clinic Campus and with a clear international focus.

The IDIBAPS research community includes over 2,000 professionals and a hundred multidisciplinary groups that carry out high-impact translational research aimed at addressing biological and clinical questions relevant to human health, as evidenced by the more than 1,500 original articles published each year that make the institution one of the main biomedical research centres in Spain.

The Clínic Campus offers a high-level research and innovation environment, which includes the Hospital Clínic of Barcelona, a referral hospital committed to care, research and teaching, which covers practically all medical and surgical specialties, plus the University of Barcelona's Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences. The latter dates from 1843 and is today one of the most prestigious health sciences faculties in Spain and worldwide.

Since 2015, IDIBAPS has had [HR Excellence in Research](#) accreditation from the European Commission. It is a CERCA centre and is accredited as a Health Research Institute by the Carlos III Health Institute (ISCIII).

5 R1 positions for promising and motivated predoctoral researchers to join DYNAMIS – Doctoral programme Yielding Novel Advancements in Medicine and Innovative Solutions, co-funded by the IDIBAPS and the European Union (EU) grant agreement Nº 101217395. Additional positions may be awarded in the event that positions from the previous call, already awarded, cannot be filled or are declined, subject to availability and institutional approval.

Requirements for all the candidates

1. To accomplish the eligibility criteria listed below (more information on the eligibility criteria is available on the Guide for Applicants on the DYNAMIS website):
 - a) Having already completed studies that grant access to a doctoral programme in Spain by the call deadline. In particular:
 - i. For studies conducted within the European Higher Education System: university degree and Master (at least 300 ECTS) or equivalent education to access to a PhD programme in Spain or,
 - ii. For studies conducted within a Non-European Higher Education System: university degree that gives access to doctoral studies in the Country of issue (certified by the competent body).

In both cases all the documentation must be delivered both legalised and **officially translated in English** (if applies).
 - b) Not have resided or conducted an activity (study/work) in Spain for more than 12 months in the last 3 years prior to the call deadline (according to the Marie Skłodowska-Curie programme's mobility rule).
 - c) Not already hold a PhD.
 - d) Good command of English.
2. To mandatorily select three potential host research lines. Each research line is co-supervised by a clinical scientist and a translational researcher. The description of the research lines is available on the [DYNAMIS website](#).

Conditions of the fellowship

- **Type of contract:** Temporary predoctoral contract (4 years).
- **Working hours:** Full time (37,5 hours / week).
- **Funder and official project code:** EUROPEAN COMMISSION - 101217395
- **Incorporation into IDIBAPS:** A research centre of excellence in the city of Barcelona.

Excellent research results and competitive project grant awards, both national and international.

- Long-life training offered by the institute.
- **Working conditions:** Holiday entitlement of 22 days + 6 days for personal affairs, flexible working hours and flexible remuneration (health insurance, transport, meal vouchers, training).
- **The chance to form part of a dynamic work environment:** We are a team with a wealth of experience that jointly evaluates ideas and strategies and promotes a healthy work-life balance.
- **Annual gross salary:** €30,770.40 (including living and mobility allowances)
- **Optional:** €7,920/year family allowance for eligible fellows with family obligations (such as marriage, a relationship with equivalent legal status, or children) either at the time of recruitment or acquired during the programme. Proof of family obligations will be required.
- **Access to training and career development opportunities:** the fellow will take advantage of the training programmes and seminars offered by IDIBAPS, as well as programme-specific doctoral schools and international and/or intersectoral secondments. How to apply

Submit the requested information through the Smart Peer Reviewers online platform by **accessing the application form via this [link](#)**. When creating your account on the platform for the first time, we recommend checking your SPAM folder if you do not receive the confirmation email in your inbox.

- All information in the application form (i.e., both your responses and the uploaded documentation) **must be provided in English**.
- The application can be saved as a draft and submitted at a later stage. Please remember to submit your application before the call deadline; otherwise, it will not be received.
- To be able to submit your application, you must complete all mandatory questions and upload the required academic documentation. Specifically:
 - For studies completed within the European Higher Education Area (EHEA): candidates must provide proof of having completed at least 300 ECTS credits. Completed studies are required (i.e., the Master's thesis — or equivalent — must have been defended by the call deadline). All academic transcripts and relevant degree certificates must be uploaded. This includes transcripts and certificates for all previous university degrees (e.g., Bachelor's and Master's).
 - For studies completed outside the European Higher Education Area (EHEA): in addition to academic transcripts and degree certificates for all previous degrees (e.g., Bachelor's and Master's), candidates must provide evidence that their qualifications grant access to doctoral studies in the country where they were obtained. To this end, they must

upload a Certificate of Eligibility signed by a competent authority (a template is available at this [link](#), if required).

In all cases, submitted documents must be officially translated into English and duly legalized.

- Part of your application involves providing the contact details of two referees, each of whom will be asked to submit a letter of recommendation (which will be considered part of your application materials). It is recommended that you inform your referees in advance and submit your application in a timely manner to facilitate the process.

Once you submit your application through the platform, you will receive a confirmation email, and the Human Resources Department will automatically receive a copy of your application and supporting documents.

Selection process

The international peer-reviewed evaluation process follows [open, transparent and merit-based recruitment criteria](#). After this recruitment, DYNAMIS will be able to invite the final selected candidates. The evaluation process is divided into the following phases:

1. Eligibility check: it determines whether a candidate fulfils the eligibility criteria.
2. Remote evaluation phase: it selects the best eligible candidates in terms of excellence.
3. Oral on-line interview: it judges the candidate's scientific and disease-oriented knowledge, motivation, and alignment with the programme and the selected research area and group.
4. On-site visits: it allows candidates to get familiar with the institute's facilities and environment; they and their potential hosts will be able to know each other, discuss potential ideas for the PhD project, expectations, and assess the compatibility between their research interests and competencies.
5. Start of the fellowship: The exact date of incorporation will be agreed with IDIBAPS once the fellowship is granted.

The employment contract will be in accordance with the provisions of Legislative Decree 1/1995, of 24 March, approving the text of the Workers' Statute Law, of Law 14/2011, of 1 June, on science, technology and innovation in accordance with the provisions of Art. 2 of Royal Decree 2720/98, of 18 December (BOE of 8 January 1999), Law 12/2001, of 9 July (BOE of 10 July) and concordant provisions.
